WHEREAS, the Bernards Township Board of Education believes the supplementation of its capital reserve is consistent with efficient and effective management of district facilities and financial resources; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the Bernards Township Board of Education hereby authorizes the supplementation of its capital reserve fund with a transfer not to exceed \$1,800,000 pursuant to the authority under N.J.S.A 18A:7F-41(6)(a) and NJAC 6A:23A-14.3(a).

Be it Further Resolved that of the \$1,800,000 authorized for transfer to the capital reserve fund an amount not to exceed \$800,000 is hereby specifically reserved to apply towards the Bernards Township Board of Education's outstanding bonded indebtedness.

10) RESOLUTION **supplementing a current expense emergency reserve fund** pursuant to N.J.S.A 18A:7F-41(6)(c)(1) and NJAC 6A:23A-14.4 (a)(1)(iii)

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A 18A:7F-41(6)(c)(1) and NJAC 6:23A-14.4(a)(1)(iii) allow the supplementation of a current expense emergency reserve and

WHEREAS, the Bernards Township Board of Education believes the supplementation of its current expense emergency reserve is consistent with efficient and effective management of district financial resources; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the Bernards Township Board of Education hereby authorizes supplementation of its current expense emergency reserve fund with a transfer not to exceed \$500,000 pursuant to the authority under N.J.S.A 18A:7F-41(6)(c)(1) and NJAC 6A:23A-14.4(a)(1)(iii.)

11) The Bernards Township Board of Education does hereby approve **disposal of equipment/books** for the 2015-16 school year; list maintained in the Board of Education office.

12) The Bernards Twp. Board of Education does hereby approve a contract with the firm of **John Standish Perrin Architect LLC** for the provision of construction administration services for the period June 27, 2016 to September 2, 2016, for a fee not to exceed \$15,500.

15) HEREBY RESOLVED that the Bernards Township Board of Education (“Bernards BOE”) **authorizes its counsel, K&L Gates LLP, to communicate with counsel for Horizon Blue Cross Blue Shield of New Jersey** (“Horizon”) that the Bernards BOE agrees to pay to Horizon the total sum of \$300,000 in settlement of the claim by Horizon for amounts Horizon claims are due under a Financial Settlement Agreement effective July 1, 1992 (the “FSA”) and a Minimum Premium Supplement to the Financial Settlement Agreement dated September 15, 2010 (the “MPS”); that said amount shall be paid within 30 days after the Bernards BOE and Horizon execute a mutually satisfactory Settlement Agreement; that said Settlement Agreement shall include mutual releases under which the parties release all claims under or in connection with the FSA and the MPS, including all claims for a Reserve, Deficit or Undercap, as those terms are defined or used in the FSA and the MPS, but which releases do not extend to claims for benefits by Bernards BOE employees under the terms of the relevant benefit plan contracts; and that said Settlement Agreement be maintained as confidential.

HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that Roderic McLaughlin is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the Bernards BOE, a Settlement Agreement containing various terms including those set forth above.
