The bus will drop off at the Lunt-Fontanne Theater, located on West 46th Street between Broadway and 8th Avenue, at approximately 11:30 AM. Lunch is on your own. Show time is 2:00 PM. Show run time is 2 hours & 30 minutes, including one intermission. Bus will depart NYC immediately following the show.

About the Tickets: Tickets are \$95 per person – includes Mid-MEZZANINE seating and motor coach transportation. Non-refundable once paid. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.

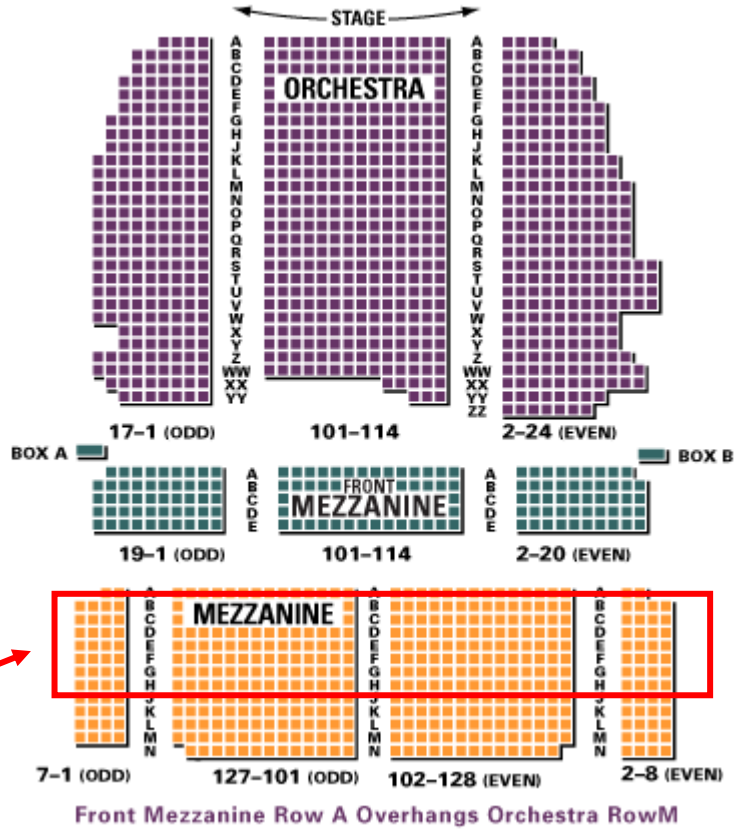
