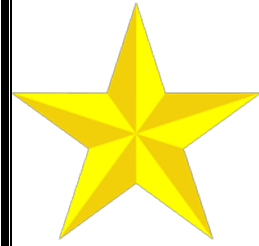


Bernards Township Parks & Recreation Broadway Bus Trip

About the Show: From Grammy® winners Steve Martin and Edie Brickell, the new Broadway musical directed by Tony® winner Walter Bobbie and inspired by a real event, this original musical tells a sweeping tale of love and redemption set against the rich backdrop of the American South in the 1920s and '40s. Literary editor Alice Murphy, whose relationship with a young soldier just home from World War II, awakens her longing for the child she once lost. Haunted by their unique connection, Alice sets out on a journey to understand her past — and what she finds has the power to transform both of their lives.

About the Trip: The bus will depart the Municipal Building Complex, located at 1 Collyer Lane, Basking Ridge. You will receive your tickets on the bus. The bus will drop off at the Cort Theater at 138 W 48th Street, between 6th & 7th Avenue, at approximately 11:30 AM. Lunch is on your own. Show time is 2:00 PM. Show run time is 2 hours & 30 minutes, including one intermission. Bus will depart NYC immediately following the show.

About the Tickets: Tickets are \$70 per person – includes BALCONY seating and motor coach transportation. Non-refundable once paid. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult. May be inappropriate for children under age 12.

You must be registered with the Recreation Department prior to attending an activity. 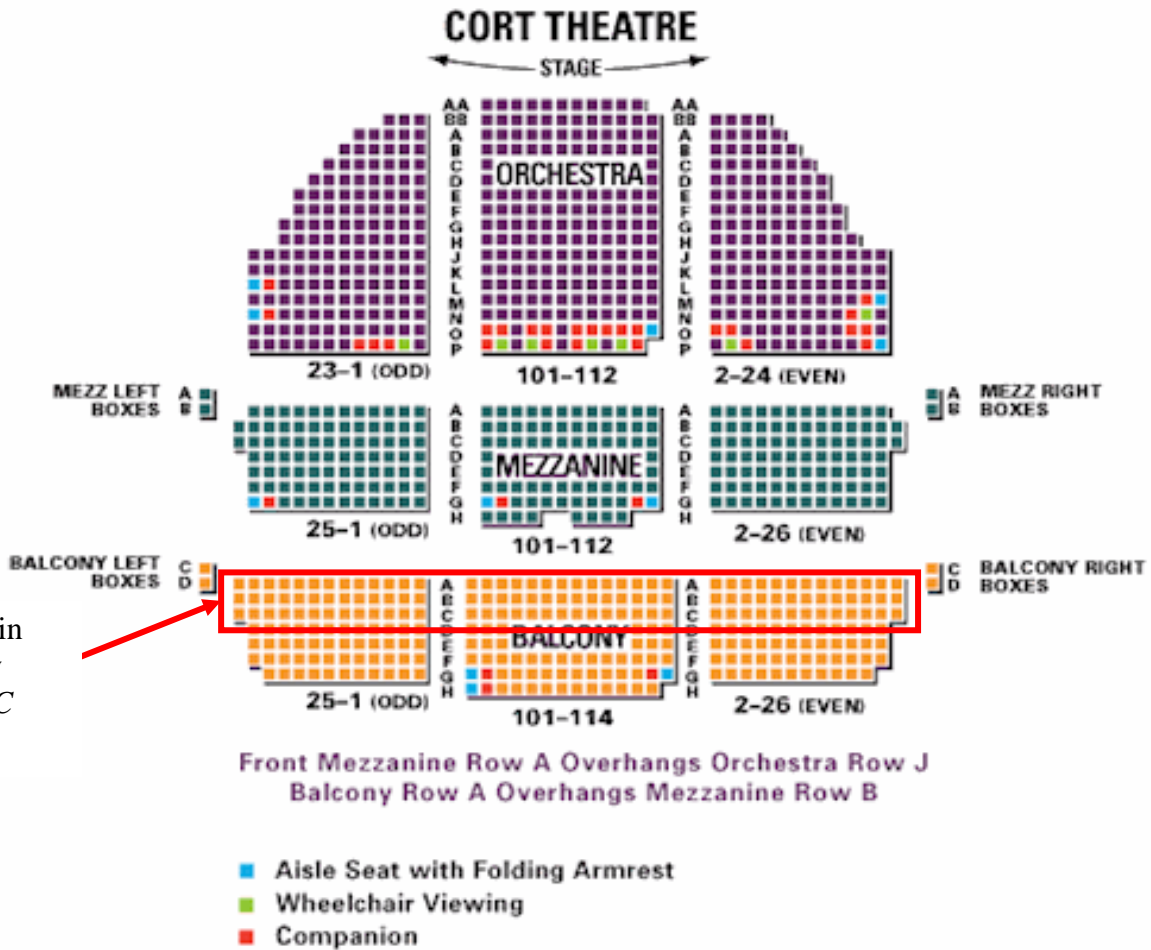

Theatre is not completely wheelchair accessible. There are no steps into the theatre.

Balcony Location: Up 3 flights of stairs. Please note: On the Balcony level there are approximately 2 steps down per row. Entrance to Balcony is behind Row F.

Handrails: Available at the end of every stepped seat row in the Mezzanine and Balcony.
