What is HPV?

Genital Human Papillomavirus (HPV) is the most common sexually transmitted virus in the US. About 6 million people get infected each year. HPV can cause cervical cancer in women and is associated with several less common cancers, such as vaginal and vulvar cancers in women and other types of cancer in both men and women. It can also cause genital warts and warts in the throat.

Why get the HPV Vaccine?

HPV vaccine is important because it can prevent most cases of cervical cancer in females, if it is given before a person is exposed to the virus. HPV Vaccine is given as 3-dose series.
