

Summer Trip Camp



WHAT: Bernards Township Teens entering 6th-9th Grade (2011-12 School Year) are welcome to take part in this year's enjoyable day trips!

All trips are chaperoned and campers will remain with their group assignment during trips. Camper to staff ratio is 8:1.

A minimum of 30 registrants is required, with a maximum of 40.
