Official Contest Rules

Essay, Video, & Picture Guidelines

In 100-300 words, or as a video response, or in picture format, answer the question "Why Do You Want To Become The Director of Play"?

On a separate cover sheet, entrants are required to provide name, age, address, phone number and years as a YMCA member, volunteer, and/or donor (if applicable). Do not include identifying information in your essay.

The Rules

All entries must be submitted in person or digitally to jharabedian@somerset-hill-symca.org by May 31st, 2011. Entries received after this date will not be considered. All information contained in the entry must be attributable to the author. Essay submissions must be at least 100 words in length.

Please include your name on a separate cover sheet. Your name must not be included in or on your essay. Entries are to be judged anonymously by a non-partial panel of judges. Failure to comply with this rule will result in disqualification.

All entrants agree to have all or part of their entry published on the Somerset Hills YMCA web site and in marketing materials. Rulings of the judges are final and are not open to debate or public criticism. Entrance in the contest implies understanding and compliance with all the above rules. Failure to comply with the rules may result in disqualification.

By submitting an entry to the contest, you are acknowledging your acceptance of the above rules and providing the Somerset Hills YMCA the absolute right and permission to take, use, copyright and publish your entry, in whole, in part, or in composite, for purposes of promoting the Somerset Hills YMCA. You waive all rights to inspect and/or approve printed or broadcast matter.

All entries must include the signature of the entrants parent or guardian granting approval of minor to participate in contest and acknowledging agreement with the rules.

The Prize

The winners will be featured in a YMCA marketing campaign that may include print, web and email marketing materials. The finalists will be featured on the YMCA website. The prize is not redeemable in cash and must be accepted as awarded. All winners, finalists and entrants agree to allow their likeness and entry to be used in Somerset Hills YMCA marketing campaigns for this and future purposes.
