Dear Grade 2 Parents/Guardians:

The Cognitive Abilities Test (COGAT) will be administered to students in Grade 2 beginning Tuesday, March 22. Testing will take place each morning on Tuesday, March 22, Wednesday, March 23 and Thursday, March 24. On Monday, March 21 students will take a practice test, which will be sent home at the end of the day on Monday. Make-up dates are scheduled for the week of March 28. Make-ups will be administered by Mr. Rauschenberger in the Guidance office.

The COGAT test is a test of reasoning and problem solving. The test measures both general and specific cognitive abilities. These abilities are assessed in three domains: Verbal, Quantitative, and Nonverbal. Verbal will be given on Tuesday, Quantitative on Wednesday, and Nonverbal on Thursday.

Since all tests will be administered first thing in the morning, please be sure your child receives proper rest and arrives at school on time. Any other appointments should be scheduled outside of the test week, if possible. If a child arrives after 9:00 a.m., he/she may not be permitted into the classroom and will be required to make up that portion of the test during the make-up days. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to contact Eric Rauschenberger, Guidance Counselor, who is our building test coordinator.
