Dear LCS Families,

It's time to leave your mark on LCS! This year, students are invited to share what LCS means to them by designing a one-of-a-kind illustration that will be placed on a tile and mounted on the walls of LCS forever. These illustrations should be created on the 4x6 template that is provided on the following page. Students may use crayons, markers, paint, or colored pencils to make their illustration. Once all illustrations are submitted, the Scholarship Committee will begin the process of turning them into personalized tiles. At the end of the year, the completed tiles will be mounted on the walls of LCS for students and families to look back on and enjoy for years to come.

The cost of each tile will be \$20. This price will cover the tile, shipping and handling, and mounting the tile on the wall. All proceeds from the fundraiser will benefit the Margaret Dooley French Scholarship Fund (formerly the LCS Centennial Service Award). This scholarship is awarded annually to two Ridge High School seniors who have graduated from Liberty Corner School and exhibit outstanding character in their contributions to the community.

All completed illustrations must be returned in an envelope, along with a check made payable to "Liberty Corner School" no later than Friday, May 20, 2011. Please address envelopes to: "Timeless Tiles—attention Miss Kalfus" and make sure to include the students name on it.
