Dear Parents and Guardians,

All of the third, fourth and fifth grade students learn to play the recorder as part of the general music curriculum. It is expected that this experience will assist students in learning to read music and understanding the concept of pitch relationships within the staff.

If your child already owns a recorder, he/she should bring the recorder to music class by November 29, 2010. The recorder and case (ziplock bags can be used) should be labeled with the child's name and classroom teacher. **Other students can purchase a recorder using the order form below.** Those students who order a recorder through the school will receive their recorders in February. Recorders will be kept in school, though I may occasionally ask the students to bring the recorders home to practice. At the end of the school year, the students should bring their recorders home.

The cost of your child's recorder is \$4.00. Please send a sealed envelope with a **check made out to "Mount Prospect School"** and/or the bottom portion of this form to Ms. Kagel no later than Monday, November 29, 2010. Please write your child's name and their homeroom teacher's name on the front of the envelope. All money must be collected before the instrument order can be placed. Funds are available, if necessary.
