FIELD DAY

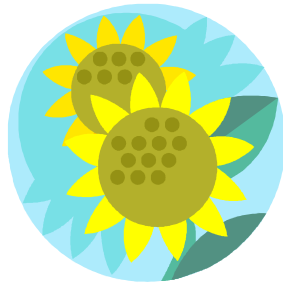
