We're asking for your help on this one.

As you experienced last Saturday evening, the pickup situation is a challenging one. We were fortunate to have the Bernard's Township Police Dept. available to assist in traffic as well as a few parent volunteers... thanks.

But, we also need your cooperation. 14 buses need to travel along Quincy and safely enter the "oval". Additionally, over 600 tired kids are looking to you for their safe return home.

Please consider the following:

Carpool: Carpooling is the #1 biggest contributor to reducing the volume of cars. Please team up with your neighbors this week and plan alternate pick-up duty over the next 3 trips.

Parking Lot: Clearly, there are not enough parking spots (see Carpooling above). Only park in designated parking spots; Do not park/stand in the lanes or along the curb. This blocks early arriving cars and is a hazard to the kids going through the lot. If there aren't any parking spaces available, exit and park along one of the side streets. Stay close to the curb so you don't block drive-thru traffic.

No Parking Zone: For safety and emergency reasons, one side of Quincy (between the oval entrance and Atlas Road) will be designated as a "No Parking" zone. Emergency Services must be able to travel down Quincy in the event of an incident. Please look for the signs and obey the No Parking zone.

The Oval: Under no circumstances are cars allowed in the oval. We have approximately 800' of buses that need that space.

Remember the three Cs: Courteous, Considerate and Cautious. Add Patience to that and we will have all of you home without incident.

Again.... Please help us keep the kids safe.
