WAMS-AO is offering an opportunity to all students, 6th thru 8th graders, to participate on the WAMS Wrestling Team. The wrestling season runs from mid November thru February. The team will meet three times per week for a combination of practices and matches.

Registration: To register for the team please submit the following by October 18th. Forms can be found at www.williamanninpto.com under WAMS-AO Forms. All registration materials must be sealed in an envelope marked "WAMS-AO" and deposited in the WAMS-AO mailbox in either the school's office or cafeteria.

1. Player Profile Form
2. Non-refundable deposit check of \$100 payable to WAMS-AO to reserve your roster spot.
3. Athletic Pre-Participation Physical Form (Part A&B)
4. Health History Update (If you already have a current Physical Form on file with WAMS-AO and it will not expire before the first practice/tryout date, you may simply submit this form instead of the complete Physical Forms A&B)

Please make sure the vision exam is complete and the MD SIGNS the form and does not just stamp it!!

Please note: NJ State requires that any student intending to participate in an extracurricular activity have submitted a standard athletic physical form completed by the parent and examining physician. The exam had to have taken place within 365 days of the first practice/tryout. A school-hired physician will then review the form. Faxed or photocopied forms are NOT acceptable. The examining physician must sign the form with an original signature—**no stamped signatures will be accepted. Forms will be returned for incompleteness.**
